

KGD CORE CURRICULUM

Students have graduated from our Junior program, and now begin their pathway through our Senior School. Students are now at an advanced level, and it is here where the door opens for more opportunities. At the Senior level, students will have the same dance genres as previous levels, consisting of:

- Cecchetti Classical Ballet
- Jazz
- SFD Tap
- Hip Hop
- Contemporary / Lyrical
- Triple Threat (Musical Theatre)
- Acrobatics / Tumbling

*To meet the technical requirements for Contemporary, students are required to also study a technique class in Ballet or Jazz.



KGD DISTINCTION PROGRAM

Across our ACCELERATE, ELEVATE, FINESSE and ACHIEVE levels, our more dedicated Ballet students continue to train full-steam ahead within our Distinction and Excellence pathways, designed to nurture strong technique, artistry and performance excellence. At each stage, students undertake a minimum of two ballet classes per week, including their general Ballet class and the appropriate Cecchetti Ballet exam class, ensuring they are working towards the correct technical standard for their examinations held in March each year. To further accelerate progress, students are strongly encouraged to also participate in the Ballet exam class above their level (without sitting the exam and at no extra cost), allowing them to train at the highest possible standard and achieve fast-tracked results across all dance genres.

As students demonstrate the required strength, alignment, maturity and commitment, additional opportunities become available. At appropriate stages, students may be invited to join Pre-Pointe classes, marking an exciting milestone in their ballet journey. Eligible students may also be invited to join our Competition Team, with age divisions progressing from 10 & under, 13 & under, 16 & under and Open Age, depending on their level and readiness. Competition Team members participate in an additional 60-minute class per week, learning three to four competition routines that are performed at two major competitions throughout the year, with selected

routines also showcased at our end-of-year performance in December.

Throughout these levels, students gain access to a wide range of enrichment opportunities, including our Summer Intensive programs with industry-renowned teachers, masterclasses, school social events, audition opportunities and prestigious awards days run by Cecchetti Ballet Australia. These experiences are designed to build confidence, creativity, performance quality and a deeper understanding of the professional dance world.

Each year concludes with our Presentation Evening in December, where students are celebrated as they graduate to the next level and are awarded their certificate and medal. Students undertaking Ballet exams and those committed to the KGD Distinction & Excellence programs receive special acknowledgement for their dedication, discipline and outstanding achievements beyond the standard curriculum.

SHOWCASE:

An impressive feature that KGD boasts is our annual end of year Showcase Performance in December. KGD is renowned for our spectacular end of year showcase, where attention to detail, costuming that is always commented on and choreography that is second to none! Students spend a substantial amount of time midway through term 3 and whole of term 4 preparing for our highly-anticipated performance. Not only does this prove to be a very fun-filled and exciting evening for all, students can also benefit so much from the experience of performing in a professional theatre and all it has to offer, including our amazing and detailed costuming, professional lighting, professional backdrops and special effects. Most of all though, students will be continuing to develop their performance abilities, learning to work as a part of a team and increasing their confidence.



PAYMENT METHOD & CONDITIONS:

- All fees are inclusive of GST.
- All fees are bundled into an All-Inclusive Package with the payment split over 11 monthly payments (February-December). The monthly fee excludes all school and public holidays.
- Customers will still receive an invoice per month, and the payments will be debited on the first day of each month, with the exception of February's payment mid-way through after re-enrolment has taken place, date to be advised to all customers.
- Where a customer enrols part way through a term/month a pro-rata "catch up fee" for all extra inclusions will be added, depending on the date enrolled.
- All customers are to sign up with our direct debit provider 'Wordplay' via the link you will be emailed upon enrolment, you can nominate your chosen bank account. We encourage you use a bank account instead of credit card for lower transaction fees.
- While we encourage a yearly enrolment to ensure you see improvement and results with your training, the minimum enrolment at KGD is for (1) term and should a student decide to cancel enrolment or change classes/packages, this can only be done via writing to info@kgdancers.com prior to the commencement of the new term. The full term's worth of payment will still need to paid should a student stop attending part way through a term, as a student holds a place in their classes for the duration of (1) term minimum.
Please note: Fees are non-refundable, (unless a class is cancelled by KGD).
- Fees for absent classes cannot become a credit for the following term, nor can they be transferred over to other siblings, however students can do a 'make up' class provided they do so in the same term. Please contact reception prior for approval and to discuss appropriate class (max 2 make up lessons per term).



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Can I participate in a trial lesson before deciding to enroll at KGD?

Yes! We offer an introductory trial lesson for all new students, giving your child the opportunity to experience a class and see if it's the right fit for them.

The trial lesson fee is \$16, payable at reception prior to the class. If you choose to enrol, this fee will be credited toward your first invoice.

How do I enrol?

Log onto our website; www.kgdancers.com Click the 'Enrol online' button, This will take you through to our online registration portal to select your choice of classes. You will receive a confirmation email shortly after to confirm. If unsure with your class decision, please contact us and we will happily assist.

Do we need the full uniform for the first lesson?

No you do not need to be in uniform for your first lesson. We suggest you just wear comfortable clothes, ie; leggings, tracksuit, singlet, t-shirt, etc and perhaps runners or bare feet for your first lesson to ensure you enjoy the class first and wish to continue prior to going out and purchasing your uniforms and correct dance shoes.

Can parents watch classes?

Similar to kindergarten, primary or high school settings, we've found that students learn best and stay most focused when it's just the teacher and students in the studio. This helps them build confidence and make faster progress in their dancing.

All of our teachers and staff are fully qualified, and we have a wonderful team of student helpers on hand to assist younger dancers with things like toilet trips, changing shoes, and getting organised – ensuring every child feels comfortable and supported throughout their class.

We do, however, love sharing your child's progress! During Open Viewing Week in Terms 2 and 3, we invite parents and carers into the studio to see what students have been working on.

Outside of viewing weeks, parents are welcome to drop and go, relax in our cosy foyer and watch TV, or pop over to the café across the road, which also has a kids' play area.

Is there parking available?

Yes, there is parking available on-site as well as street parking nearby for your convenience.

Where do we go for our first lesson?

We recommend arriving a little early for your first lesson to allow time to check in at Reception and find out which studio your child's class will be held in. Our friendly staff will be there to help you get settled and answer any questions.

Do you offer refunds or credits for missed classes?

Unfortunately, we're not able to offer refunds or credits for missed classes. However, we do provide two make-up classes per term for each student.

To arrange a make-up class, simply email us with the date of the class your child missed and the date of the make-up lesson you'd like to attend, and we'll organise this for you.

My child wants to start Ballet & get her Pointe shoes. When can she do this?

Firstly, the student must be at least 12 years of age for their feet to be anatomically ready to begin Pointe work. Even then the student must have had a few years of ballet training & experience behind them. If the student meets the above criteria and displays an appropriate level of technique required, she will be then invited by the principal to partake in a weekly 'Pre-Pointe' class for 6 months at a minimum, to strengthen her ankles, feet and core before acquiring her Pointe shoes and commencing Pointe work.

When KGD staff consider the student to be almost ready, the student will be referred to In Sync Pilates & Physiotherapy in Camberwell to be assessed for Pointe readiness. Once KGD staff and the Physio are happy with the student's progress, an appointment at BLOCH Dancewear in Malvern East will be made for the student to be fitted with their very first pair of Pointe shoes.

What age can my child start Ballet exams?

Generally once a student at KGD has reached age 5-6 and assuming they are demonstrating the required standard of technique, along with showing commitment to their classes and an excellent work ethic and attitude to their fellow peers and teachers, they will be considered by the principal to be invited in our annual in-take of examination candidates.
