DRESS REHEARSAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Parking: Is literally anywhere you can find it! Perhaps first try the Casey Arc car-park, then perhaps around near the old council offices.

Please arrive through backstage door 'Magid Drive'. **Please note: You will need to find parking first, then walk around to Magid Drive and enter through the 'garage/roller door' into the loading bay area (please stick to white pedestrian walk-way for safety). Older students may have a parent drop them off in the loading dock then leave straight away through the exit roller door, this would be strictly drop-off only, there is no car-parking in the loading dock. Younger students that need entry with an adult will need to do as suggested above.**

Please try not to be late, as late arrivals will affect the flow of the whole day.

The dressing rooms will be located on 'ground' level, along with the stage (same level you will enter on), we will only be using the ground level rooms for this day. On the day of the showcase we will have allocated dressing rooms for each group split across 3 levels.

Please note: this rehearsal is a FULL DRESS rehearsal, as well as correct hairstyle (for the performances) HOWEVER THERE WILL BE NO FULL STAGE MAKE-UP as we will not be having photos done on this day (showcase only)! 'First time' mums – please do not feel overwhelmed at attempting the hairstyles, we will have some helpers there to assist you! If first time mums would like to attempt the make-up on this day as a 'practice' for the real show, then please feel free. A photo of our 'stage make-up' and products list will be emailed out shortly. ☺

Please note; No competition routines will rehearse on stage this year, due to time limitations.

PLEASE ARRIVE AT LEAST 20-30 MINUTES PRIOR to your allocated time, to allow for parking, find your way (as this is new for everyone), have your hair styled, costume on and warmed up ready to go. Older students once ready, please find a spot backstage and quietly warm-up, especially if you have demanding steps in your routines (ie; splits, leg mounts, jetes, acrobatics, etc)!

Please note; parents will NOT be allowed in the auditorium or side stage to watch this rehearsal. If there are students who have to wait around for quite some time, they are highly encouraged to sit in auditorium to watch, as they will not see each other perform on the night and students can also gain a lot from watching these stage rehearsals through observation (stage craft, performance, inspiration from senior students, etc) and supporting their fellow peers.

This year we have so many students participating in multiple routines across various age groups and levels, unfortunately due to scheduling reasons we will have some students in 'back-to-back' items for dress run, in this instance the parent only of this child may accompany them up side stage to help with any quick changes.

All students must be in the CORRECT SHOES AND TIGHTS which will be listed in the final newsletter to follow. The only exception being older children with 'back-to-back' routines/costume changes.

Parents of all pre-school children are to please stay in the dressing rooms the whole time your child is required, in order to help them with their costume changes. In the event that you cannot, please either arrange for a friend to help your child or notify reception so we can be sure to arrange a designated helper for them and please clearly mark all their bags and belongings so we know where to find their shoes, etc. Students will be escorted to and from the stage by teachers and student helpers.

All costumes will be transported to and from the venue by staff.

Under no circumstances are costumes to be taken home at end of rehearsal, please leave at theatre, otherwise you will be liable if they need to be replaced or fixed.

Please pack snacks and drinks for your child if they are to be there for a substantial amount of time, however costumes must be covered by a dressing gown/jacket in order to eat and drink! No sticky lollies or cordial, soft drinks etc (water only) please! In the event a costume becomes ruined or stained as a result of food and drink you may be liable for the purchase of a new one.

Please be sure to pack items to keep younger students entertained, (ie; colouring in books (with pencils only), teddies, toys, books, etc), if they have a substantial amount of time to wait around.

Please note; No jewellery (earrings, watches, etc), or nail polish to be worn.

Hairstyles neatly slicked back with gel, hairspray etc in correct style (TBC). Please refer to latest newsletter (to come shortly).

Any experienced mums who feel they can offer their assistance to any new 'first-time' mums – please feel free to do so, it would be greatly appreciated! ☺

Please remember; PUNCTUALITY is important on this dress rehearsal day – as we have so many more classes/groups this year, most groups will receive only 10-15 minutes stage time,...It is crucial that this day runs like 'clock-work', as late comers will affect the flow of the whole day, leaving our older students dancing late well into the evening. Your understanding of this is much appreciated. When arriving, please allow plenty of time for car-parking.

Lastly, please remember this is a COMPULSORY Dress Rehearsal – if students are absent they will miss out on orienting themselves with the stage, learning which wings to enter and exit, their spacings any spatial changes, important stage craft theatrics and general theatre etiquette, etc, which will unfortunately affect their fellow peers and the quality of their own performance on the day.
